- He worked as dancer artist in the Zero dance piece by Yankelle Filtser, and in 2021 as a dancer artist in Gloria by Yael Schiller.








IRAD AVNI, Choreographer and dancer

OVERVIEW:

The show is around 80 minutes long without an intermission.

The show features six dancers.

Additional crew members:

- Lighting designer
- Stage manager
- Dresser

MINIMAL STAGE SIZE:

- Width: Gross 16 meters, net (without legs) 12 meters.
- **Depth:** Gross 10 meters, net (from the backdrop to the front of the stage) 9 meters.
- Height: 7 meters.
- **Passageways:** Leave a 1-meter space from the backdrop, leave a passageway in the legs for the dancers.

STAGE FLOOR:

Smooth wooden floor without depressions or protrusions.

TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE STAGE:

- Black linoleum that will cover the entire area of the stage 9x12m (adjust to the size of the stage if it is a different size)
- Black insulating tape for adhering the linoleum
- 8 black legs (4 on each size)
- Border

PROPS (THE PRODUCTION'S RESPONSIBILITY):

- Backdrop composed of two parts that are hung on a rear tackle.
- Table with a hazer installed on it requires access to electricity for charging before the show.
- Snow machine hung mid-width of the stage, on a tackle in the front third of the stage.

*** There should be an available freezer near the stage to store ice cream used in the final part of the show.
